Mrs. Boyle folders are going home once again, please ensure your student is completing all tasks as assigned. These folders go home Thursdays and should be returned completed Tuesdays.

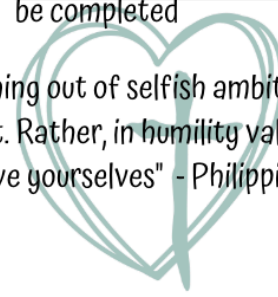
Students have voted and would like to go to City Museum for their May field trip. Info will be sent home mid April.

Looking ahead:

RELIGION	Students will begin Theology of the Body, similar to Family Life, this quarter. We will complete this alongside our religion curriculum during 4th quarter. This program conveys the worth and dignity of the human person and our road to happiness through the Blessed Trinity.
MATH	5th grade will continue with Chapter 10, multiplying and dividing fractions. We are working our way through Multiplying Whole Numbers and Fractions. 4th Grade will begin Chapter 9 Operations with Fractions. All students continue to work on their timed math facts test.
SCIENCE	4th & 5th grade have finished Lesson 2 in which they learned how organisms, including newly introduced species, affect ecosystems. With this, we are finished with Unit 4 and will begin our Review and Study Guide. We will complete the Study Guide as a class and it will closely resemble the test. Our Unit 4 Test will be on March 31st.
SOCIAL STUDIES	Students will wrap up our chapter on the Southeast and begin Chapter 7 The Midwest. This chapter students will review all states from the Midwest, Northeast and Southeast.
ELA	Students will be wrapping up our review of Unit 18 in spelling. They have also completed their spelling of our SE Region states. Unit 19 focuses on consonant changes for 5th and final -le and -en words. Grammar finds both grades understanding of use of relative pronouns and antecedents. Students Close Reading books continue making connections and inferences with their reading. We will begin our new trade books as well. 5th Grade will read The Goldfish Boy and 4th will read Class Dismissed.
