Looking ahead:

RELIGION	We continue to work through the Church Celebrates Seven Sacraments. Students will wrap the chapter with Kahoot and their test on 9/17. Our next lesson will focus on the Life of Christ.
MATH	Both grades will wrap up Chapter 2. 5th graders will move on to Dividing by a One Digit Divisor. 4th grade will focus on Understanding Multiplication and Division. Math timed tests continue to see progress for all students.
SCIENCE	Students will begin to understand the relationship between technology and engineering and how engineers use the design process to solve real world problems.
SOCIAL STUDIES	We will begin Chapter 2 Americans and their History, learning to identify significant events in our history and famous figures connected to them.
ELA	4/5th grades have finished our first unit in our Close Reading. Tradebooks begin! 5th graders will be reading How to Steal a Dog, while 4th graders take on The Whipping Boy. We will complete our Review Unit, revisiting words and their patterns from the first five units. In Simple Solutions, both grades will complete their Unit 3 tests. We continue to work through our ELA program Study Island as well.
